 3        That Congress disapproves the rule submitted by the Se-  
 4        curities and Exchange Commission relating to “Staff Ac-  
 5        counting Bulletin No. 121” (87 Fed. Reg. 21015 (April  
 6        11, 2022) and a letter of opinion from the Government  
 7        Accountability Office dated October 31, 2023 (which was  
 8        printed in the Congressional Record on November 1,

1 2023, on pages S5310-5312), concluding that such Staff  
2 Accounting Bulletin is a rule under chapter 8 of title 5,  
3 United States Code), and such rule shall have no force
