A BILL

To amend MAP–21 to modify provisions relating to a categorical exclusion for projects of limited Federal assistance, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Small Projects Expe-
5 dited Execution and Delivery Act” or the “SPEED Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION FOR PROJECTS OF LIM-**
7 **ITED FEDERAL ASSISTANCE.**

8 Section 1317(1) of MAP–21 (23 U.S.C. 109 note;
9 Public Law 112–141) is amended—

- 1 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking
2 “\$6,000,000” and inserting “\$12,000,000”; and
3 (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking
4 “\$35,000,000” and inserting “\$70,000,000”.

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
